Student Pledge

- ◆ I will attend school regularly.
- ◆ I will be honest and reliable.
- ◆ I will arrive to school on time and remain in school a full day.
- ◆ I will wear my proper school uniform every day.
- ◆ I will be prepared for the school day by completing my homework every night and bringing all necessary supplies to school.
- ◆ I will turn in all assignments on time.
- ◆ I will show respect for myself, treat others with respect, and respect the environment.
- ◆ I will accept responsibility for my own actions.
- ◆ I will resolve conflicts peacefully.

Parent (Guardian) Pledge

- ◆ I will volunteer 18 hours per family to help the school (25 hours for two or more children).
- ◆ I will participate in the Parents as Partners organization (PasP).
- ◆ I will be honest and reliable.
- ◆ I will ensure that my child arrives at school every day on time. If my child takes the bus, I will ensure that he/she is at the bus stop on time.
- ◆ I will ensure that my child is in proper academic uniform each day and prepared for school by having the necessary academic supplies.
- ◆ I will attend school functions and parent student teacher conferences.
- ◆ I will limit my child's time spent watching TV, playing video games and listening to the radio.
- ◆ I will know what my child should be learning and talk regularly with the teachers and my child.
- ◆ I will help with my child's homework and read with my child regularly.
- ◆ I will provide adequate rest, food, and medical attention so that my child is ready to learn.
- ◆ The school remediates students who are below grade level. I understand that my child may be required to attend an extended day tutoring program and agree to support the school's efforts.

Teacher Pledge

- ◆ I will be honest and reliable.
- ◆ I will arrive to school on time every morning.
- ◆ I will grade student assignments quickly and ensure that all students are aware of their academic standing.
- ◆ I will communicate with the families at least four times yearly.
- ◆ I will respect the cultural differences of students and their families.
- ◆ I will continue efforts to develop professionally.
- ◆ I will provide a curriculum that promotes literacy and numeracy.
- ◆ I will explain assignments clearly and provide meaningful homework.
- ◆ I will encourage students and parents by providing information about student progress.
- ◆ I will provide a safe, pleasant and caring learning atmosphere.
- ◆ I will provide resources to help all students be successful in their school experience.
- ◆ I will maintain high expectations for myself, students, and other school staff members.
- ◆ I will assist students in developing a sense of personal and civic responsibility.
- ◆ I will help students learn to resolve conflicts in an appropriate and positive manner.
- ◆ I will support the mission and vision of the school and work to develop the whole child.

Steps to Conflict Resolution

1. Request Teacher conference to clarify issue
2. Contact Principal if unresolved with the teacher
3. Contact Board Designated Parent Representative
4. Contact the President of the Governing Board
5. Present issue at the next scheduled Board Meeting if unresolved
6. Seek mediation with the Sponsor
